- Description**
- Tests, maintains and/or troubleshoots (with appropriate test equipment) rotating equipment and associated devices utilizing schematics, vendor manuals and procedures.
 - Participates in process/procedure development
 - Function as a primary resource for mechanical equipment related problems
 - Assists other technicians, maintenance technicians and operations staff when necessary and supports efficient effective teamwork in the performance of duties.
 - Responsible for the safe operation of company owned vehicles
 - Provides accurate detailed work history for reporting routine functions and provides training to other technicians.
 - Participates in a rotating night/weekend call-out program and periodically work scheduled and unscheduled night and weekend assignments.
 - Participates in and implements safety programs to minimize personal injury and property loss.
 - Participate and complete the Maintenance Qualification Program requirements.

- High school or equivalent. Appropriate technical school training with minimum of three years in process maintenance activities. Ability to utilize manuals in the repair of equipment. Must have knowledge of mechanical theory and principles, test equipment usage, common and mechanical tools, safety and good work practices and techniques.
 - Driving on company business is a requirement of this position and as such, the incumbent shall have and maintain a valid driver's license. Must have basic computer skills and the ability to operate a forklift and hydra crane. Overnight and short-term travel on company business is an expected part of this position.
 - Performs repetitive and non-repetitive physical duties requiring lifting, pushing, pulling, stretching, bending, climbing, working in awkward positions and lifting of up to 50 lbs. Performs other duties as assigned by supervision.
